Mark 16:15 - And then he told them, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone."

Romans 3:20-22 – No one can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. For the more we know God's law the clearer it becomes that we aren't obeying it. But now God has shown us a different way to be made right in His sight... by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are.

1 Peter 3:15-16 – Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way. Keep your conscience clear. Then if people speak against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ.

John 14:12-14 – "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!"
