The following questions are designed for use personally or within a group setting to help you dig deeper into today's message. If you're not connected with a group, please visit: www.netchurch.cc/netgroups to see what groups are currently meeting.

****After the message** we invite you to take **communion** with us – Stations are located near each exit. This is a tradition long practiced by followers of Jesus (see 1 Corinthians 11:23-26). At The Net we take communion by dipping bread (representing Christ's body) into a bowl of juice (representing Christ's blood) and eating it. This practice is called intinction. We also invite you to receive **prayer** during this part of our service. Leaders available to pray with you can be identified by their lanyards and will be standing in the auditorium at the lower exit to your left.

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
