



Net Group Discussion Guide Week Six: God is Everywhere!

INTRODUCTION

In this final message on wisdom, we explored all the places God can show up. The obvious and not so obvious places. The attractive and the not so attractive. In the end, what we discovered is that God is everywhere and His wisdom is all around us. The only question is: will we capture what's before us or foolishly let it pass?

GETTING STARTED

- What did you either grow up believing or previously believe a "walk with God" was supposed to look like?

THINKING THROUGH IT

- What spiritual disciplines have been emphasized the most to you over the years? What effect has that emphasis had on you? Both good and bad.
- What do your "obvious places" to find God look like today? What do you struggle with most when it comes to these places?
- At one point, Ryan said, "There's no limitation to where God can be found. So, there's no limit to what counts as spending time with God!" Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Why?
- Read Psalm 139:7-12. What is this passage saying to you? How do you see it connected to this past Sunday's message?
- Where have you seen God show up in a not so obvious place?
- Ryan mentioned looking for God in places to which we are naturally attracted. He mentioned movies as a place he often finds God. What are some of your favorite places to hear from God outside of the Bible and other traditional settings?
- Now for the hard part. Where are your least favorite places to hear from God? What have you learned from these settings?
- Looking ahead, where in life might it be helpful for you to get another point of view? Who can you seek out to get that?

- What do you believe God is saying to you through this message and time of discussion?
- What step can you take this week to follow through on what you believe you're hearing?
